Barry Alan Warren, 69, Las Vegas, NV, formally of Rome, NY passed away suddenly at his home on Tuesday, July 18, 2023. Barry was born October 18, 1953 in Rome, NY. He was the son of the late Burdett and Leona Warren. Barry graduated from Rome Free Academy in 1971 and then from Mohawk Valley Community College in 1973 with an Associate's Degree.

After graduating from college Barry moved to Las Vegas, NV where he worked in the casino industry as a Craps Dealer. Barry left Las Vegas to pursue a career as a Stock Broker eventually returning to Vegas to get into the beer business. He created a special recipe called "Nevada Jack" and used Matt's Brewery Company in Utica, NY to brew his special beer.

In the late 1980's Barry cofounded Cellular USA selling cell phones and accessories in Las Vegas. He grew the business to 6 stores throughout Las Vegas and Seattle, Washington. In the early 2000's Barry sold his business and moved to Margarita Island in Venezuela where he lived for 20 years.

Barry returned to the states often to visit family and friends in Las Vegas and Rome. Barry enjoyed telling entertaining stories and loved sharing memories of meeting famous people in Las Vegas and his dealings with the beer business. He enjoyed traveling across the world and was always up for new adventures.

Throughout his life Barry was very active and enjoyed many sports including scuba diving, tennis, skiing, golf, and recently pickle ball.

Barry was kind, genuine, and a good hearted person who took pride in

meeting new people and making countless lifelong friendships. Barry deeply loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them, especially having a rum and coke by the pool. He was the best father, bar none and he was completely devoted to his best friend, Shalee and their daughter. His nieces and nephews all adored his adventurous spirit, his kindness, and the sincerity he showed each of them. Barry always enjoyed challenging them in sports, games and the philosophy of life. He always had a way of making a simple get together turn into a memorable conversation.
