Carl Taylor, 94, of Las Vegas, passed away Nov. 07, 2021. He was born July 25, 1927, in Gilmore City, IA and resided in Las Vegas for 58 years. He was retired from the United States Marine Corps as Master Gunnery Sergeant E-9 and Florida Cypress Gardens as Procurement Manager. Carl served during the Korean and Viet Nam wars. He was awarded the Navy Achievement Medal; Combat Action Medal; Presidential Unit Citation; Meritorious Unit Citation; Good Conduct Medal with four stars; National Defense Service Medal with one star; Vietnam Service Medal with four stars; Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with palm and the Vietnam Campaign Medal with device. Carl was a Life Member of the Marine Corps League. He is survived by his wife, Barbara Taylor, to whom he was married for 40 years. He was preceded in death by his parents Charles and Mary Taylor and 12 siblings. He truly loved nature, working in the outdoors, boating and loved fishing, especially salmon fishing in the North West.
