Damian Kane Hansen was born December 26, 1973 in Hammond Indiana. He entered into eternal life on Thursday, October 29th, 2020 after suffering a stroke.

He was adopted at an early age by his loving grandmother Elizabeth Hansen. Athletic and energetic, Damian loved acting, breakdancing, baseball, swimming and diving. He was on the Gavit High School Swim Team receiving many 1st place awards in diving and going to State Competition. He was also a member of the Snowball Rockers travelling dance group.

Following in the footsteps of his father, Damian became an accomplished entertainer. Damian, known as DJ Damian Kane, began spinning at age 15 at his high school dances in Hammond Indiana. After playing at night clubs around the Northwest Indiana and Chicago area, he moved to Las Vegas in 2000. He was the resident DJ at Moose McGillycuddy's, DJ for Full Tilt Entertainment, Redbull, and a variety of celebrity events. He also served as a guest DJ at Carnival Court at Harrah's Las Vegas, Baja Blue and numerous other venues and events. He was the resident DJ at Stoney's Rockin' Country for many years up to his death.

Damian is survived by his darling five year old daughter McCartney, who was the treasure of his heart, his large family: his devoted mother Elizabeth Hansen of Lake Forest, IL, brother William of LaJolla California, sister Amy Hansen of Tempe Arizona, adopted brothers and sisters: Ralph (Joyce) of Lake Forest IL, Steve (Lynda) of Munster, IN, Jim (Nicki deceased) of Monroe,
