Danielle Clara Skerritt-Seskin of Las Vegas, NV, born September 17, 1966, died unexpectedly on May 22, 2024. She was 57 years old. Born in Willingboro, NJ, to Dolores Skerritt and Cyrus Seskin, she lived most of her adulthood as a Clark County resident. She was currently employed as an art teacher at Legacy Traditional School - Southwest Las Vegas, a job she loved. She graduated from Willingboro High School in 1984, earned her Bachelor's Degree in Television Communications from Temple University in Philadelphia, PA, and her Masters in Education - Curriculum & Instruction from University of Nevada Las Vegas. Danielle was a caring and compassionate soul who loved all animals and plants, enjoyed gardening, fostered puppies, practiced Nichiren Daishonin's Buddhism and was a loving mother who adored her family. Her laugh was large, silly and sweet, spreading warmth and drawing laughter from all around her. Brave and adventurous, on her last summer vacation, she drove from Las Vegas to New Jersey to visit family and old friends from Willingboro, living in various states, with her son, his two kittens and her precious service dog Lana and even stopped in New Orleans just to have dinner! She was a huge Philadelphia Eagles fan who watched every game in her Eagles Jersey and goofy eagle hat both of which she wore proudly. In her own words she was a "Mother of four. Art Teacher.
