We are heartbroken to announce the passing of Darrell Lee Holt, who left us on July 9, 2023, in Las Vegas, NV from cardiac arrest. His adventurous spirit led him to try his hand at acting in the early 2000s, where he appeared in the TV show "Las Vegas." A memorial party was held in his honor last August, with about 70 close friends, family, and coworkers traveling from near and far to
