Jeremy Michael Stanis, age 46, passed away on November 18, 2025, in Las Vegas, Nevada. He was born on August 15, 1979, on Whidbey Island, Washington, to Kenneth Stanis of Kingsland, GA, and Anita (Juanerio) Stanis Ziebell of Port Hueneme, CA.

He amassed an impressive collection of ice hockey jerseys and proudly displayed his love for the sport. He also enjoyed playing golf and cheering on the Florida Gators.
