Jerry Sablow (Julian Maller) was born in 1943 in Los Angeles, CA to Irving Maller (who passed before Jerry was born) and Evelyn Silver. Evelyn married Sam Sablow in 1947. Julian, who preferred to be called Jerry, officially changed his name to Jerry Sablow in 1965. Jerry graduated Cal State Long Beach and also law school. After law school, he was recruited to work for the United States government as an auditor. He worked at various locations in Southern California at the DCAA (Defense Contract Audit Agency). He specialized in defective pricing which involves auditing the prices that defense contractors charge the government. He often said that he had saved the tax payers several times more money than he was ever paid. He retired after over 30 years with the government and moved to Las Vegas. He was married to Barbara Ann Wolf from 1965 to 1982, then Pauline Lasoff from 1982 to 2009, and Betty Sponder from 2010 until Jan 2021. Pauline and Betty preceded him in death. After Betty passed away, he was going to move into assisted living but broke his ankle and was in rehabilitation for six months. Unfortunately, while in rehabilitation, he caught COVID-19 pneumonia and passed away Oct 6, 2021. He is survived by his sons, William and Michael, and three grandchildren.
