Joan Helen Baeszler Conlon, 78, of Henderson, NV, born in Providence, RI, to Dr. John Lewis Baeszler and Helen Johnson Baeszler, died November 17, 2019, surrounded by her five daughters & son-in-law: Julie Marie Conlon, Leslie Diane Conlon, Alicia Christine Conlon Perkins, Jennifer Joan Conlon Moore, Geraldine "Dina" Patricia Conlon Bilo, and Scott T. Bilo. Joan died from a hospital-caused complication following admittance for a bleeding ulcer. In addition to those mentioned above, Joan is survived by her five grandchildren: Zachery John Moore, James Taylor Moore, Griffen Richmond Perkins, Aidan Conlon Perkins, and Evelyn Conlon Bilo, as well as son-in-law Richard C. Moore, her younger brother Paul Michael Baeszler, nieces & nephews, and fiancée to oldest grandson Zachery, Justine S. Colgin. Joan graduated magna cum laude from Salve Regina University. She was the first woman to have a dissertation published at the Vatican in which she argued both sides of virtue. Joan lost a son, John William Conlon III shortly after his birth due to heart issues, as well as the love of her life, John William Conlon, Jr., in 2014 after 51 years of marriage. Together this couple, madly in love set off on an adventure together. Joan was VP of her and her late husband's manufacturing company. Joan was an active political volunteer as well as in the community, helping those less fortunate. Joan's eldest twin daughters were born with learning disabilities. Joan was a trail blazer in the public school system in CT to better serve those with disabilities. Joan made this world a better place. Her laughter, fascinating and hysterical stories, zest

for life, extensive vocabulary, imagination, and class made her a true original. She is missed already and will remain so as she is celebrated for all she has accomplished and pioneered. We love you more than anything, Mom.
