



Joseph Robert Stanley

January 4, 1949 - April 30, 2025

Joseph Robert Stanley, age 76, passed away from congestive heart failure on April 30, 2025, in Las Vegas, Nevada. He is survived by his wife, Charlotte Stanley; his daughter, Stephanie Floyd; and his son-in-law, Marc Floyd, all of Las Vegas, NV. He is also survived by his grandson, Chris Floyd, and his partner, Chelsea Evaristo, of Ham Lake, Minnesota, along with his great-grandchildren, Cash and Cooper Floyd—whom he was very proud of. He is preceded in death by his father, James R. Stanley, and his mother, Elizabeth Stanley.

Born on January 4, 1949, in Muncie, Indiana, Joseph was the son of James R. Stanley and Elizabeth Stanley. He graduated from Southside High School in 1967 and immediately enlisted in the United States Air Force. His service began at Hahn Air Base in Germany, and he transferred to Las Vegas in 1972, where he settled permanently.

Joseph was a devoted family man and loving father. He married his high school sweetheart, Charlotte Prince, on January 31, 1969, and the couple shared 56 wonderful years together. They had one daughter, Stephanie. An active and social man, Joseph was deeply involved in the local magic and martial arts communities. A talented close-up magician and mentalist, he performed at countless events, spreading joy and wonder wherever he went. He was also a third-degree black belt in Shotokan karate and remained committed to the discipline for many years.

Proud of the Italian heritage, Joseph was an active member of several

community organizations, including the Fiore Club, the Grandsons of Italy, and Las Vegas Traditional Shotokan Karate. He will be remembered by all who knew him as a straight shooter—genuine, dependable, and full of character. A Celebration of Life will be held on Saturday, May 17, 2025, at 11:00 AM at Lone Mountain Missionary Baptist Church, 6319 W. Lone Mountain Rd., Las Vegas, Nevada 89130, with a reception to follow at the church. Pastor John Richardson will officiate. All are welcome to attend and honor Joseph's life. A separate interment service will be held at a future date at the Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Boulder City, NV, where his cremated remains will be laid to rest with honor.

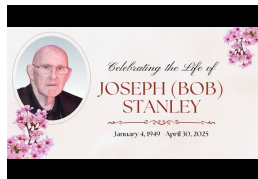

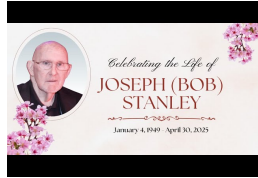
