April 21, 1975 - April 25, 2026

After a fierce and faithful battle with metastatic breast cancer, Karen Razy Condos, age 51, passed away on April 25, 2026. She was a beloved wife, mother, daughter, sister, aunt, niece and friend.

Karen was born in Las Vegas, Nevada on April 21, 1975, to Don and Elaine Razy. From the time she was very young, she was artistic, bright and nurturing. Her dolls were well cared for, and her bedroom was filled with the supplies of a Maker.

She graduated from Chaparral High School in Las Vegas in 1993, after which she studied early childhood education at Southern Utah University. She was a faithful member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and served a mission for the church in New York City from March of 1996 - October of 1997. She loved serving her Heavenly Father and cherished the opportunity to create many life-long friends and memories. Following her missionary service, she resumed her studies at UNLV and met Patrick Condos, her forever love, during that time. They were married in the Las Vegas temple on December 29, 2000, and were grateful to later welcome their children, Katelyn and Zackary, into their family. Karen graduated from the UNLV school of education in 2002 and then worked as an elementary school teacher, a substitute teacher, and an online tutor throughout her life.

Karen's truest happiness is in being a devoted wife and mother; her connections with Patrick, Katelyn and Zackary brought profound meaning and purpose to her life. She also found great joy in spending time with her extended family and friends, visiting Disneyland, playing games, and sharing what she loved with others. She always showed up for people, remembered birthdays, and made thoughtful gifts. And she was SO creative: she made crafts, gingerbread houses, Covid masks, doll clothes, and Mickey Mouse ears. And through all of it, she made meaningful memories and loving relationships. She will be remembered for her deep faith, her joyful laughter, her willingness to be silly, as well as her strength of character and determination.

We are grateful for, and inspired by, the faith and hope that sustained Karen through the last several years of her battle with cancer. She felt truly strengthened by her relationship with God, and by the many people that showed her selfless service, prayers and support. As a family, we could not be more thankful that Karen left this mortal life feeling truly loved. We take comfort in the knowledge that Karen is free from all suffering now, and in the loving care of her dad, her granny, and her Heavenly Father.

She is survived by her husband, Patrick, and children Katelyn Elaine and Zackary George; her mother, Elaine Lucas Razy; and her siblings Kimberly (Eric) and Kristen (Jon). She was preceded in death by her father, Donald Joseph Razy, and her grandmother, Laura Lopez Lucas.
