



## MarJean Matheson Mansoor

May 17, 1941 - October 19, 2020

Earth lost an angel this week. The absolutely beautiful, kind, gentle MarJean Matheson Mansoor passed away peacefully in her sleep on Monday, October 19, 2020 at the age of 79.

MarJean was widowed by the love of her life, Mahmoud Mohammed Mansoor, May 9, 1995. She was never the same after he passed away overseas on his religious Haj to Mecca, Saudi Arabia, where he is buried. As a lifetime member of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, MarJean's wishes were to be buried with her parents, Duayne and Alice Matheson, her sister Joy and her grandparents in the Matheson family plot in Cedar City, UT, her hometown.

MarJean and Mahmoud met in Cedar City in the late 50s, were wed in 1960 in Chicago, IL, then lived in San Bruno, CA in the 60s/70s, then made their final move to Las Vegas in 1977. She was very active in the LDS church playing piano for Primary School in San Bruno, singing in the choir for years and was an active member of the Relief Society and Temple for decades as well as an active member of the Daughters of Utah Pioneers. She loved singing, playing piano, music, sewing, cooking, reading, movies and most of all, her family.

MarJean is survived by her very large and loving family which includes Steve

& Vicki Matheson (her brother & sister-in-law), her children, Majid Mansoor (son), Melinda Mansoor (daughter), Mariam & Waled Al-Arda (daughter & son-in-law), Michele & John Stevenson (daughter & son-in-law) and her grandchildren, Masoud Al-Arda, Mahmoud Al-Arda, Tasneem Al-Arda, Yusef Al-Arda and Yunes Al-Arda. She leaves behind her loving kitties Alex and Sasha who were with her when she passed and stayed with her as guardian angels.
