In preschool his grandfather called him the "mayor" because he knew everyone, and everyone befriended him. He was a natural athlete. As a child he skateboarded, played soccer, baseball, roller hockey, and basketball. In adulthood he expanded his horizons to the martial art Muay Thai, running, hiking, weightlifting, fly fishing, mountain and road biking, BMX, paintball and archery.

Throughout his years Mason worked as a DJ, skateboarding teacher, restaurant worker, clothing and car sales, while living all over the world, from England, Spain, Australia (where he attended college earning a bachelor's degree in digital arts), to NYC and Thailand.
