There will be no services per Mikes request

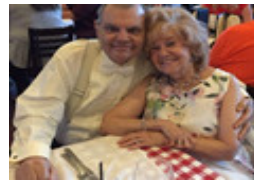
Afterglow

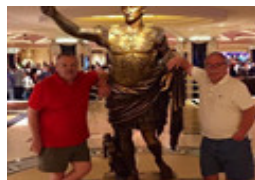
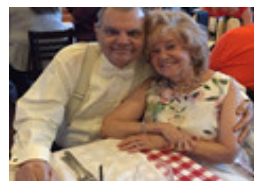
