“The measure of a man is not in the years he lived, but in the love and legacy he leaves behind.”

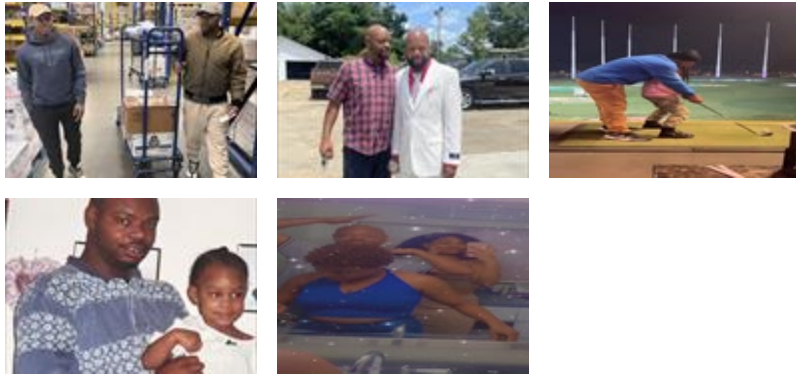
