Paul David Clark, 77, passed away on December 28, 2023. He was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on December 18, 1946. He was child 9 in a family of 12 children. He grew up in a densely wooded area, nicknamed Happy Hollow, just outside of Plainfield, IN.

Paul served in the Vietnam War. His primary duties included aircraft and helicopter maintenance. He also served as a medivac.
