Psalm 23 Traditional

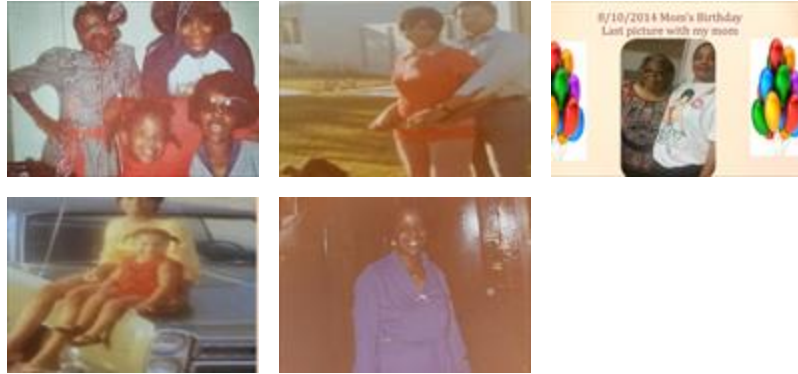

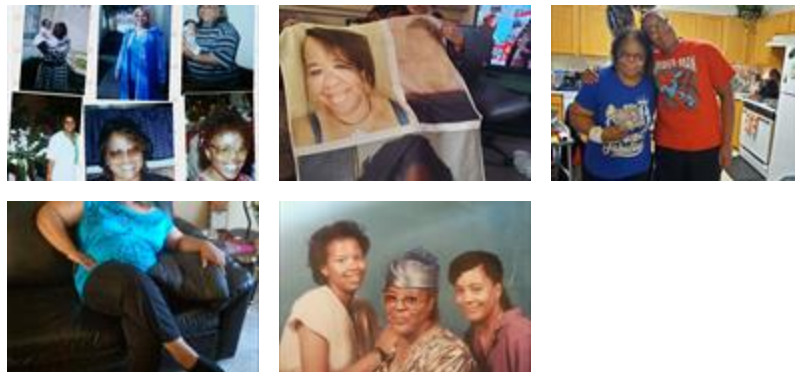
