The family would like to give a special thank you to the ICU staff at University Medical Center for giving comfortable and compassionate care to our loved one.

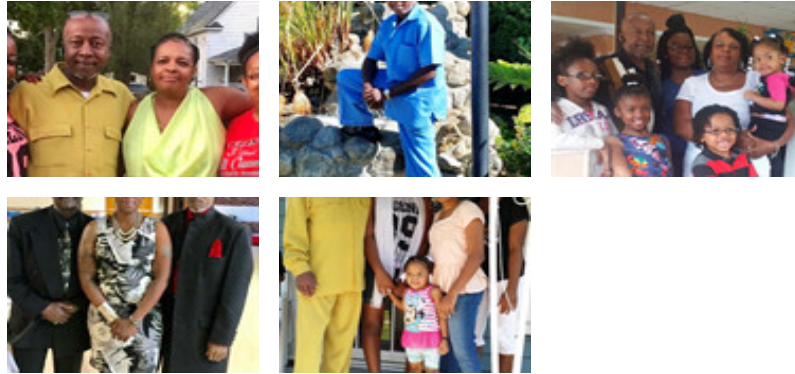
