



Robert Louis Zeichick

May 25, 1937 - January 30, 2022

A celebration of life for Robert Zeichick, 84 year old Las Vegas resident who passed away Sunday evening at a private residence, will be held by his family weekend of May 20th, 2022. Details to come. Robert Louis Zeichick was born on May 25th, 1937 in Cleveland, Ohio to Robert and Rose Zeichick. He was the eldest of two children, him and his brother Melvin Zeichick. The family moved to Boyle Heights, east Los Angeles in 1948. There, his father Robert, nicknamed "Lindy", worked in the junk yard business and his mother Rose, nicknamed "Jerry", did clerical work. He graduated from Fairfax High School in 1955. He then attended Los Angeles City College where he played football as a running back.

He was married on March 25th 1966 in Las Vegas, Nevada to Lori Stec. During that time he had an import business and frequented the race tracks, while Lori worked for a medical office. They made their home in Encino, California where they raised three boys at the "Magnolia house."

He was a salesman throughout his life. His first job was selling shoes, then he moved into the photography business. Later in life he owned International Specialties, an import export business for lighting. He also owned Bronx Pizza and a wholesale travel agency in the 80's. Most would say he was a Jack-of-all-trades.

He later remarried LuAna Stewart on August 13th, 1984. They worked in real estate flipping homes in the San Fernando Valley. They had two children of their own they raised in Woodland Hills, California at the "Felice Place house."

Robert, nicknamed "Puggy", enjoyed sports, both playing and betting. He spent many years coaching his sons at Encino Little League and pop Warner football. He enjoyed travel and, most of all, quality time with his family.

In his remaining years he resided in Las Vegas, Nevada with his partner Sonya Ross. They enjoyed the events and shows offered by the city and led a social life.

He will be remembered most for his vibrant personality. He was one of a kind. He is survived by his Ex wife Lori Zeichick of Havasu, Arizona; Ex wife LuAna Zeichick of San Diego, California; partner Sonya Ross of Las Vegas, Nevada; four sons Joseph Zeichick, of Los Angeles, California, Jamie Zeichick of Las Vegas, Nevada; Jack Zeichick of Los Angeles, California; Anthony Zeichick of San Diego, California; one daughter Nicole Herzog and her husband Paul of San Diego, California; one grandson Jaxon Zeichick, and one granddaughter Paris Zeichick.

He was preceded in death by his parents, and one brother Melvin Zeichick.
