



## Salvatore Joseph Sberna

August 4, 1929 - October 7, 2018

Salvatore J Sberna "Sal" died peacefully from natural causes, with his family present at Infinity Hospice on October 7th, at the age of 89.

Sal is survived by his wife of 43 years Sung Ae and children Salvatore Sberna III of Houston, Texas, Frank Sberna of Las Vegas, Nevada, Stephen Sberna of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Joan Sberna of Las Vegas, Nevada and Tony Sberna of Fargo, North Dakota. He is preceded in death by his parents and one son Anthony Edward Sberna of Las Vegas, Nevada.

Sal was born on August 4, 1929 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Upon the death of his mother, at the age of 13 Sal dropped out of school to care for his younger sister Joan. After Joan was married Sal joined the Air Force where he pursued his high school diploma and entered college. Sal graduated from Texas State University in May of 1975 shortly after his retirement from the service at the rank of Master Sargent.

In November of 1976 Sal moved his wife Sung Ae and their children to Las Vegas Nevada where Sal worked at Caesar's Palace, The Frontier and The California Club as well as various other gaming entities. At 75 years of age Sal began to work for the Las Vegas School District as a floor tech until the age of 80 when his health would no longer allow him to work.

Sal was a tireless and conscience worker as was recognized by awards, achievements and promotions at every job in his multiple careers. Sal was engaging and possessed an outgoing and likeable personality. You knew when Sal was in the room and you wanted to be his friend. Sal was a proud,

determined, self-made man, who took risks to better himself and his family. When Sal was 75 years old he humbled himself before God and asked Jesus Christ to forgive his many sins and enter his life. Sal today is in Heaven because of that decision.
