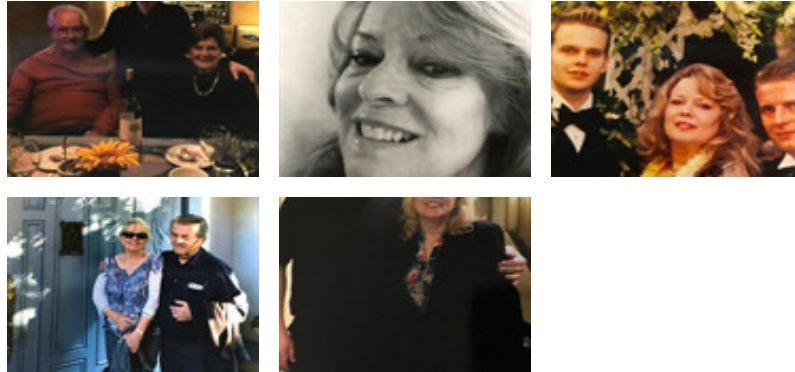
I'm Free
