



Stanley Moore Loewenkamp

October 20, 1940 - April 5, 2022

LTC (Ret) Stanley Moore "Stan" Loewenkamp, 81, decorated soldier, talented artist and dedicated husband passed away on April 5, 2022 with his wife of 46 years by his side. Stan was born on October 20, 1940 in Anderson, Indiana the son of Harold and Lucille (Moore) Loewenkamp (both deceased).

Stan graduated from Bosse High School, Evansville, IN in 1958 before attending the Chicago Academy for the Arts. Stan then joined the Army to serve his country for 22 years including 2 tours in Vietnam. After a distinguished career in the Army and the California National Guard, he retired from the military in 1990, which allowed him the time to focus his art once again. Stan was a talented artist who was represented by numerous galleries. He has work in collections throughout the US and many foreign countries having most recently won "Best of Show" in an exhibit in Las Vegas.

Stan married the love of his life, Patty Rae (Gustafson) on November 14, 1975 and is survived by her. They travelled the world together in service of our country.

He joined the Masonic Blue Lodge in 1977 and Eastern Star in 1978 and was a member of these organizations until his passing.

Survivors include his daughter Kim (Oscar) Waycaster; his Brothers, Steve (Sharon) Loewenkamp of Windsor, CO, Rick Loewenkamp and Coni Monroe of Scottsdale, AZ, Randy (Lisa) Loewenkamp of Oklahoma City, OK; grandchildren including Jamison Wathen and Chip Waycaster; 1 great grandson and many nieces and nephews.

Memorial services will be held on Sunday, April 24th at 4:00 pm at Mt. Moriah Masonic Lodge, 480 Greenway, Henderson, NV. Interment will take place on Thursday, June 16th at 10:00 in the Veterans Cemetery in Boulder City, NV.
