Thymios graduated with a Bachelors Degree in English literature from the University of Montana in Missoula, and was awarded a PhD Degree in Comparative Literature from the City University of New York.

He is a respected scholar amongst his peers with over 200 publications including four books, academic articles and short stories. His book, *Dante and Byzantium* (Carabas, 2009), has received excellent reviews, and has been used as a reference by other writers in their scholarly articles. Above all, Thymios will be remembered as a family man, who loved his sons dearly, and a scholar who prided himself on all things Greek.
