William S. Lowry Jr., of Las Vegas, NV, passed away December 23, 2021. William was born in Memphis, Tennessee to William S. Lowry Sr. and Margaret Hamilton. He is survived by his son, William F. Lowry of Louisville, Kentucky.

William attended Fremd High School in Palatine, Illinois; Williamsville North High School in Williamsville, New York; and graduated from North Central High School in Indianapolis, Indiana in 1973. William then went on to attend Northwood University in West Baden, Indiana and the Audio Institute of America.

William was a proud member of Daylite Lodge #44 and Zelsah Shrine in Las Vegas, Nevada. He was President of the Henderson Shrine Club in Henderson, Nevada, and a former Squadron Commander of the Louisville Composite Squadron CAP, in Louisville, Kentucky. He was also a member of NRA and CASA.

William held myriad positions throughout his life. He was a concert producer and talent agent, and owner of Rave Records and BILO Music Publishing BMI. He was a karate instructor for 43 years, and owned Tracy's Karate Studio in Georgetown, Kentucky. Among these professions, William was also a chef, a handgun instructor, and a private pilot.
